#### **DAAD Prize for Outstanding Achievements of Foreign Students Studying at German Universities**

In 2023, the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) will award a prize to a foreign student or doctoral student at Martin-Luther-Universität Halle-Wittenberg. The DAAD-Prize is intended to honour outstanding academic achievements and remarkable social or intercultural commitment.

In winter semester 2022/23, applicants should be at least in the 2<sup>nd</sup> academic year of an undergraduate degree programme or at least in the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of a graduate degree programme or be a doctoral candidate. The award can also be given to students who have already completed their studies (in October 2022 at the earliest).

The prize is endowed with a total of 1,000 EUR and awarded to one person only. Application is open to degree seeking foreign students enrolled at Martin-Luther-Universität Halle-Wittenberg. <sup>1</sup>

Please hand in the following documents<sup>2</sup>:

- Convincing cover letter
- Curriculum Vitae
- Current academic transcript of records indication the applicant's grade point average
- Letter of reference from a university teacher including assessment of academic performance and social/ intercultural commitment
- Proof of social/ intercultural commitment

The prize winner will be selected by the University Awards Committee of Martin-Luther-University Halle-Wittenberg. The award ceremony will take place in April 2023. The call is subject to possible funding cuts by the DAAD.

<sup>1</sup> Only international students who have acquired their university entrance qualification at a school abroad (this includes German schools abroad) or who have supplemented school qualifications acquired abroad with a German Studienkolleg are eligible to apply for the prize.
